Hurlburt Field Campus Dining System Update

Hurlburt Field, FL will become the second non-Food 2.0 pilot base to initiate the new Campus Dining System (CDS) on June 1. AFSOC is the first MAJCOM to have all bases fully implemented under the AF CDS program. Under the CDS test, active duty Air Force ESM members will have expanded benefits using a portion of their daily ESM entitlement in participating NAF activities

Hurlburt Field is the second of six installations scheduled to test CDS at non-Food 2.0 bases in FY21; Mountain Home AFB, ID, Peterson AFB, CO, Maxwell AFB, AL, Misawa AB, Japan, and Incirlik AB, Turkey are all scheduled to implement and test CDS in the next eight months. If successful, Air Force is seeking the funding to deliver CDS to the rest of the Air Force starting in FY22.

Both Capt Everson and 2d Lt Rhoads earned automatic bids to the US Olympic Track and Field Trials in Eugene, Oregon, on June 18-27.
