AFMC was the only MAJCOM in the DAF authorized to provide virtual face-to-face CPI Green Belt training after AFIMSC leadership requested interim measures to bridge the online training stoppage during the new platform vendor contract review that has been on-going since mid-September 2021. Of the 99 MAJCOM participants, AFIMSC personnel made-up 20% of attendees in addition to three class break-out facilitators, Dr. Chris Victoria (XZ), Mr. Derrick Le (AFCEC), and Mr. Russ Schickedanz (XZ). Each participant completed approximately 36 hours of pre-work academics, followed by a four-day virtual workshop via Teams. Participants learned concepts related to Lean Six Sigma, Theory of Constraints, and the Air Force's practical problem solving model, or PPSM, throughout the entire course. They then participated in a capstone exercise where they applied newly learned skills to a realistic scenario. As Green Belt trained candidates, these individuals are now eligible to continue their CPI journey by facilitating a process improvement project for official DAF certification.
