Knowledge Management (KM)

Knowledge Management is getting the right information, to the right people at the right time to make more informed decisions. With KM decreasing stove piped information and increasing awareness, AFIMSC is committed to equipping the workforce with the tools needed to capture, store, and distribute information.



Each directorate has KM representatives (1-2) who can perform basic tasks on **SharePoint**. SharePoint is a major tool used to capture, discuss, and analyze information. SharePoint is a great collaboration application that is easy to navigate and a breeze to use. KM has published a <u>SharePoint Online Training Guide</u> to help members learn more.

SharePoint How-Tos:

Let's Review Some SharePoint Functions

App Launcher – Displays a menu of available MS Online apps including Outlook, Word, PowerPoint, SharePoint, OneDrive, Excel, Teams, or **All Apps** for more options

△ **Notifications** – Display notifications within Outlook

Settings – Displays a menu with commands to view the users have access to the site, view all lists, libraries, and sub sites.

 $^{\circ}$ My Account – Displays a menu with commands to personalize your profile

 $\stackrel{\sim}{\sim}$ Follow – Allows you to quickly navigate to a site and be notified of changes

Share – Allows you to request that others have access to the site. Requests are sent to the site owner for approval

 \sim **Next Steps** – SharePoint online tips of what to do on the site. Generally used for newcomers to SharePoint Online Site
