Charter lays out AFIMSC diversity, inclusion initiatives

Armed with a recently approved charter to affirm its direction, the Air Force Installation and Mission Support Center's Diversity and Inclusion Council is working to create an organizational culture that fosters equality and equity throughout the enterprise.

AFSFC innovates to develop virtual visitor passes

The Air Force Security Forces Center is testing a virtual process to streamline visitor pass requests and reduce foot traffic at visitor control centers across the force. The DBIDS Defense Biometric Identification System Visitor Enrollment System uses smart devices and the current Defense Biometric Identification System's web-based functionality to link requestors, sponsors and VCCs in a virtual process to issues passes.

<u>AFIMSC trains 600 finance Airmen at virtual worldwide workshop</u>

Making sure Airmen and Guardians get the pay and compensation they need to concentrate on the mission is the focus of financial experts at every level of the Air Force. To make sure that continues to happen as smoothly as possible even in the COVID-19 environment, the Air Force Installation and Mission Support Center's financial services team adjusted course this year and went virtual with its annual training workshop Feb. 8-10.

Revolutionizing the flightline of the future

The Tyndall Program Management Office hosted a Flightline of the Future Summit Feb. 3 to explore opportunities to turn the base's current flightline into a high-tech resource for the missions of tomorrow.

AFCEC targets rapid airfield repair solution

The Air Force Civil Engineer Center Laboratory at Tyndall Air Force Base, Florida, is on a mission to repair battle-damaged runways as quickly as possible, with minimal materials, manpower and equipment.

AFCEC helps feed the force at deployed location

The Air Force Civil Engineer Center is leading the \$2.5 million construction of a new dining facility to streamline mealtime for U.S. and coalition forces at an allied base in the Middle East.

AFICC awards large-scale architect and engineering services contract

The Air Force Installation Contracting Center awarded a suite of architect and engineering services contracts Feb. 19, to support the Air Force's sustainment,

restoration and modernization program. The contracts, awarded by the 772nd Enterprise Sourcing Squadron, are part of the \$2 billion Architect-Engineer Next program consisting of four contractor pools.

European home appliance contracts projected to save \$85,000 annually

The letting of nine European household appliance contracts by two Air Force Installation and Mission Support Center organizations at Ramstein AB, Germany, is expected to save the Air Force roughly \$85,000 annually.

2020 successes set stage for continued housing improvements

The Air Force Civil Engineer Center's housing programs branch set out to implement 51 housing improvement initiatives. To date, housing officials at AFCEC and across the Air and Space Forces have completed all but four of the initiatives, addressed more than 5,200 resident concerns and leveraged \$32 million to hire an additional 218 housing support staff.

<u>Department of the Air Force Leaders direct second IG Disparity</u> Review

Acting Secretary of the Air Force John P. Roth, Air Force Chief of Staff Gen. Charles Q. Brown Jr. and Chief of Space Operations Gen. John W. Raymond directed the Department of the Air Force Inspector General to conduct an additional independent review of racial, gender and ethnic disparity in the Department of the Air Force.

Reduction initiative axes 506 publications, aims to empower leaders

After four years of review, the Department of the Air Force publication reduction initiative introduced in 2017 by then Chief of Staff of the Air Force Gen. David L. Goldfein is nearing a close. As of February 2021, 506 publications have been rescinded, 854 have been updated and 66 are currently in formal coordination with only 23 publications awaiting review.
