- League of Legends (*RAF Mildenhall and Kadena*)



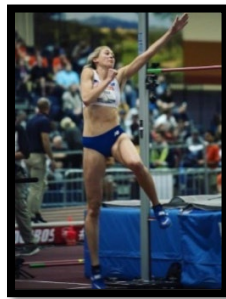
Kelly Fitness Center Fitness Equipment

Britannica ImageQuest and Britannica Library

These databases are available to you for free and accessible 24/7 from the Air Force Portal. These online resources dovetail to support wide and diverse children and young adult learning needs and interests. Both are outstanding resources for school projects, extracurricular assignments, and to explore new ideas as the FY21 Summer Reading Project approaches.

Britannica ImageQuest includes 3.3 million images from 62 leading collections not freely located on the Web. Simple keyword search, collection or primary genre, image type or image ratio is available to find most images.

Britannica Library was specifically developed to support the children and young adult pedagogical learning requirements. It allows users to identify the age and interest appropriate content. It is also tailored to assist students with school projects or simply with interest to learn something new.
