The decision to merge was validated through the Energy Assurance Unity of Effort process mapping effort. This merger will ultimately increase efficiencies and expedite project execution, helping to benefit Air Force resilience efforts.

The merger of AFCEC/OEA and AFCEC/CN combines the strengths of both organizations by creating a unified team with the people and skills needed to achieve the Air Force's goal of Mission Assurance through Energy Assurance. The combined force of the existing dedicated staff will increase AFCEC's throughput of deliverables, the probability of successful project execution, and the ability to meet Air Force energy resilience objectives.

Moving forward, this combined directorate will be known as the Air Force Office of Energy Assurance and will use the office symbol AFCEC/CN. I have attached an updated Organizational Chart that illustrates this new structure. The current AFCEC/OEA director, Mr. Kirk Phillips, has been selected to serve as Director, with Mr. Dan Soto assuming the role of Deputy Director. The new AFCEC/CN will retain its current manning locations at Tyndall AFB, FL, and in the National Capital Region, Arlington, VA.

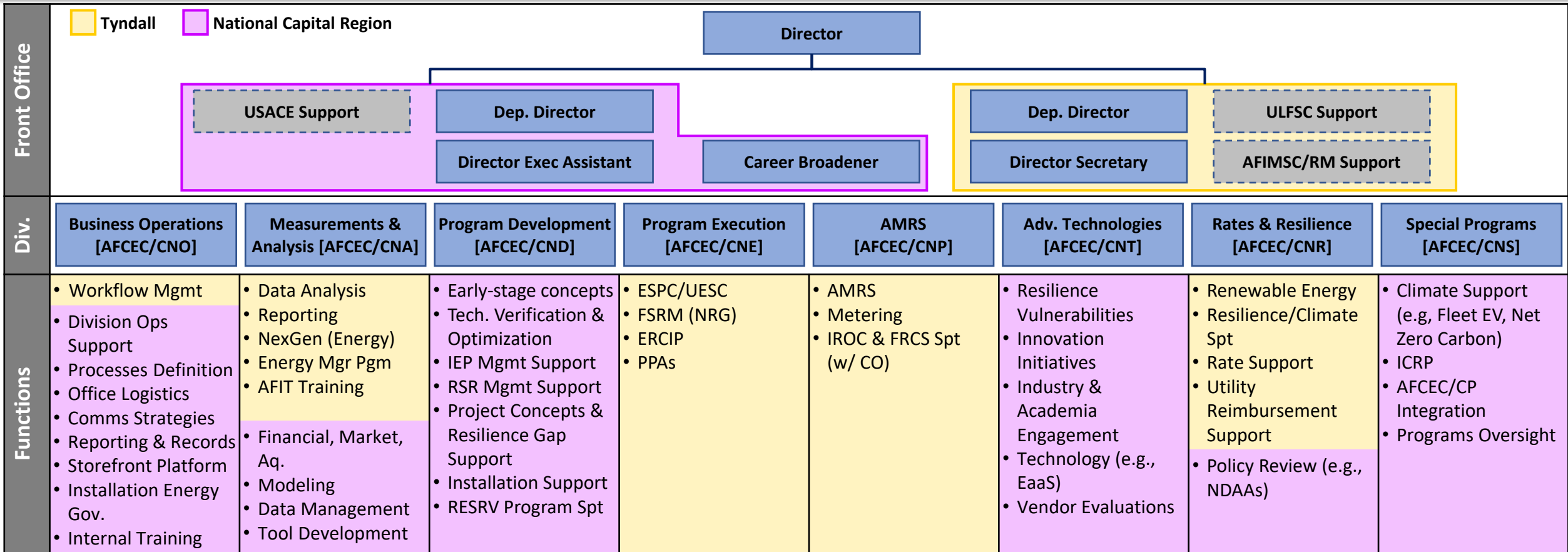
